## WIDE ROAD PAVING PROJECT (PHASE 2)

WHEREAS Council adopted resolution R2025-078 in May 2025, approving in principle the second phase of paving on Wide Road;

WHEREAS revised options with differing specifications, durability, and costs have been presented, along with updated financial analysis and a confirmed TECO grant;

#### **THEREFORE**

# CONDITIONAL APPROVAL TO PROCEED WITH COMMUNITY CAMPGROUND PROJECT

to locations designated for the operation of food

trucks;

in the municipality of Grosse-Île;

of food trucks in order to prohibit their circulation in dune environments and to modify certain provisions related to the authorization

request procedure;
