**BYLAW 2021-001 – TO AMEND BYLAW 2019-010 CONTRACT
MANAGEMENT BYLAW**

- WHEREAS** Bylaw 2019-010 regarding contract management was adopted by the Municipality of Grosse Ile on November 18, 2019, in accordance with Article 938.1.2 of the Quebec Municipal Code;
- WHEREAS** the *Act to establish a new development regime for the flood zones of lakes and watercourses, to temporarily grant municipalities powers enabling them to respond to certain needs and to amend various provisions* (L.Q. 2021, chapter 7) was assented to on March 25, 2021;
- WHEREAS** within the context of the COVID-19 pandemic, Article 124 of this Act stipulates that for a period of three (3) years, beginning on June 25, 2021, municipalities will have to take measures in order to promote Quebec businesses for any contract that involves an expenditure below the expenditure threshold for a contract that does not require a public call for tenders;
- WHEREAS** a notice of motion was given at the regular sitting of council held on May 3, 2021 and a draft bylaw was also presented at this same sitting;
- WHEREAS** a copy of this bylaw was given to each member of council at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to the present sitting;
- WHEREAS** during the course of the sitting, the Director General mentions the content and the scope of the bylaw;

THAT Bylaw 2021-001 amending Bylaw 2019-010 - Contract Management Bylaw be hereby adopted and that the following is ordered and decreed by the said bylaw:

**BYLAW 2021-001 – TO AMEND BYLAW 2019-010 CONTRACT
MANAGEMENT BYLAW**

- Article 1** Article 2 of this present bylaw is effective for a period of three (3) years, from June 25, 2021 until June 25, 2024.
- Article 2** Bylaw 2019-010 – Contract Management Bylaw is hereby amended by the addition of the following article:
- 10.1** Within the context of awarding any contract that involves an expenditure below the expenditure threshold for any contract that does not require a public call for tenders, the municipality must promote Quebec

goods and services as well as suppliers, insurers and contractors having an establishment in Quebec.

Is an establishment in Quebec: Within the meaning of this article, any place where a supplier, an insurer or a contractor carries out his activities on a permanent basis which is clearly identified with his name and accessible during regular office hours.

Are Quebec goods and services: Goods and services in which the majority of their design, manufacturing, assembly or completion are mainly done from an establishment located in Quebec.

Article 3 This bylaw shall come into force in accordance with the law.
