



PUBLIC CALL FOR TENDERS

SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL FROM MUNICIPAL ROADS AND PARKING LOTS FOR THE WINTER SEASONS OF 2026-2027, 2027-2028, 2028-2029, 2029-2030 and 2030-2031.

The Municipality of Grosse Ile (hereinafter «**the Municipality**») is requesting tenders in order to conclude a contract with a qualified enterprise for snow and ice removal from municipal roads and parking lots for the winter seasons of 2026-2027, 2027-2028, 2028-2029, 2029-2030 and 2030-2031 inclusively, in accordance with the specifications provided for in the technical clauses section of the call for tenders document. The services to be carried out by the Entrepreneur must comply to the content of this call for tenders.

Individuals and businesses interested in submitting a bid may obtain a copy of the call for tenders and all related documents on the site of the *Système électronique d'appel d'offres* (SEAO) by paying the fees according to the rates in effect established by the SEAO.

Tenders must be received in a sealed envelope bearing the following: «**Call for tenders - Snow and ice removal from municipal roads and parking lots for the winter seasons of 2026-2027, 2027-2028, 2028-2029, 2029-2030 and 2030-2031** » **before 4:00 p.m. (local time), February 2nd, 2026**. The tenders will be opened the same day, in the presence of at least two (2) witnesses, **at 4:05 p.m.**, at the municipal office, at the following address:

The bidder is solely responsible for ensuring that his bid is submitted at the office of the Municipality at the above-mentioned address. Only the tenders received before the aforementioned time and date will be considered.

Are eligible to submit a tender for this present call for tenders are bidders with an establishment in Quebec or in a territory covered by an intergovernmental open market agreement applicable to the Municipality within the framework of this present call for tenders, namely the Agreement on the Liberalization of Public Procurement in Quebec and New Brunswick, the Agreement on Trade and Cooperation Between Quebec and Ontario and the Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA).

Any interested person or group of persons wishing to participate in the tendering process referred to in this call for tenders (or his representative) may file a complaint to the Municipality regarding this process until the deadline for receipt of complaints indicated on the SEAO.

The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest nor any of the tenders received or to incur any costs of any kind whatsoever towards the bidder(s). Moreover, the Municipality declines any responsibility towards any of the bidders in the case of rejection of all the tenders.

The contract is awarded to the compliant bidder who submitted the lowest price, if applicable, by decision of the Municipality, at its sole discretion.
