

Bylaw number 2016-007 Regarding Speed Limits

WHEREAS section 4 of the first paragraph of article 626 of the Highway Safety Code (L.R.Q., c. C-24.2) enables a municipality to set, by means of a bylaw, the minimal or maximal speed of highway vehicles within their territory;

WHEREAS a notice of motion regarding the presentation of a bylaw as such was given at the regular sitting of council held September 12, 2016 and is entered in the book for this purpose at the municipal office under the number 2016-007;

THEREFORE

It is moved by Miles Clarke

Seconded by Jessica Goodwin

And unanimously approved by the Councillors present

THAT bylaw number 2016-007 be hereby adopted and that the following is ordered and decreed by the said bylaw:

Article 1

This present bylaw is entitled Bylaw regarding Speed Limits.

Article 2

No person may drive a highway vehicle at a speed:

- a) Greater than 50 km/h on the municipal roads situated within the territory of the Municipality of Grosse Ile, as stipulated in annex A;
- b) Greater than 70 km/h on Chemin North, as stipulated in annex A;

Article 3

The appropriate signage will be installed by the road maintenance contractor of the Municipality of Grosse Ile.

Article 4

Anyone who violates article 2 of this present bylaw commits an offense and is liable to a fine which is provided for in article 516.1 of the Highway Safety Code.

Article 5

This bylaw repeals any previous bylaws and resolutions of the same nature.

Article 6

This present bylaw will come into force 90 days after the adoption unless it has been subject to a disallowance from the Ministry of Transport published in the Official Gazette of Québec.
